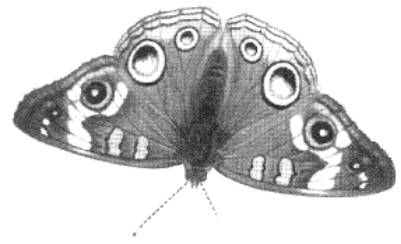

**Directions to the Randall Museum:**

The Randall Museum has limited parking. We would like to encourage folks to take public transportation, bike, walk, or carpool. If you do arrive in a car, and the lot at the Museum is full, street parking is available on Museum Way, Roosevelt Way, States Street, and Park Hill Road.

**Directions by car:** From 101 exit Fell St. Left on Divisadero St. (turns into Castro St.). Turn right onto 14th St. Stay on the left when the road forks. This will put you on Roosevelt Way. Continue up Roosevelt Way, look for museum directional sign and turn left on Museum Way. The museum and parking lot will be on your left.

**Directions by bus/walking:** Take #37 to Roosevelt Way and Museum Way. Walk to the end of Museum Way. -OR- Take #24 Divisadero St. bus to 16th St. Walk uphill on 16th St., turn right on Flint St. Enter the park on the left side of the street. Walk up the hill, past the tennis courts, to the museum.
